2. Peter's Primacy at Tabgha (Where Jesus asked Peter if He loves Him)
3. The ride on the boat on the Lake of Galilee with the visit of the Boat museum (we have to arrive at the Kibuts at 10:00 and at 10:30 to be on the boat)
4. Capernaum
5. Mount Beatitudes

DAY 4: APRIL 14 (SUNDAY)

Leaving the hotel at 8:00 AM

1. Visiting the place where the demons were cast out into the pigs
2. Caesarea Philippi
3. Tel-Dan (The place of worshipping the Golden Calf)
4. Golan Heights
5. Yardenit (The traditional place of Jesus' baptism on Jordan river)
6. Spa (hot springs in Tiberius) – Optional

Dinner - 6:00 PM

DAY 5: APRIL 15 (MONDAY)

Leaving the hotel at 8:00 AM (Everyone has to bring the luggage out of the room before the breakfast because after the breakfast we are leaving for Jerusalem)

1. Bet-Shean (Ten Cities). One of the first and most important cities in Israel from the time of Canaanites. In this city the Philistines pierced the body of king Saul to the city's wall.
2. Megido (The place where 'The Book of Revelation' takes place)
3. Caesarea by the Sea

Arrive at Jerusalem around 4:00 PM. Checking in to a four star hotel 'Leonardo' in Jerusalem.

DAY 6: APRIL 16 (TUESDAY)

Leaving the hotel at 8:00 AM

1. Bethlehem
2. Shrine of the Book
3. Miniature of Jerusalem (Model of the 2nd Temple)
4. Citadel
5. Bethesda

Dinner - 6:00 PM

DAY 7: APRIL 17 (WEDNESDAY)

Leaving the hotel at 8:00 AM (we can manage without a bus this day).

We will visit the Bethesda, where Jesus miraculously healed a man. Then, we will visit the Pretoria, the place where Jesus was accused. We will visit the Fort of Antonius, Residence of Roman Procurator, then we will go to a mountain Moria to see the 'Dome of the Rock' mosque. We will see the Western Wall and a famous Tunnel under it. From there we will go to see beautiful streets of Old Jerusalem, the market place, from Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, so called 'The way of the Cross' of Jesus. From there we will come up to the Mount of Olives for breathtaking scenery of the Old City and Cedron Valley and then come down the way that Jesus took on the 'Palm Sunday'.

1. Temple Mountain
2. Mount of Olives
3. Garden of Gethsemane
4. Kaifa's house (The Place where Jesus was accused by Sanhedrin)
5. Upper rooms
6. The tunnel by the Western Wall
7. West-South corner of the Temple Mountain

DAY 8: APRIL 18 (THURSDAY)

1. Golgotha
2. Jesus' Tomb
3. Garden of the Tomb

DAY 9: APRIL 19 (FRIDAY)

Leaving the hotel at 7:00 AM

Today we're leaving to see the Dead Sea for two days. Then we will visit the desert of Ain Gedi where David was hiding from King Saul.

We're going to see Masada as well, the last citadel sieged by the Romans. Masada has been a symbol of valor and bravery of Jewish people. 960 Jewish defenders several years resisted the Romans conquerors, choosing death instead of slavery at the end.

1. Leaving for the Dead Sea
2. 'Ahava' Cosmetic Store
3. Qumran (The place where The Dead Sea Scrolls were found)
4. Trip to the Hot Springs (Where you can swim in the Salty waters of the Dead Sea)

1. Masada
2. The rest at the Dead Sea
3. Departure (Evening of April 20th or early morning of April 21st)
