INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE IN GERMANY

From March 23-7, 2015, there was an international conference in Germany on the topic of intercultural mission work. Such conferences are usually carried out once every few years, and they are organized by IMB, the Missionary Board of the Southern Baptist Convention.

The conference was attended by about 150 people from 38 countries, mainly heads of mission projects and organizations. At the meeting, there were delegates from Africa, Latin America, Central Asia, Southeast Asia, Indonesia, India, Israel, Turkey, Korea, Cuba, China, Europe, Colombia, Venezuela and others.
