THE COST OF FOLLOWING CHRIST

What are we, as those living in America, willing to pay for our dedication to Christ? It seems like a strange question to those who are living in the U.S., doesn't it? But for those who are from many other countries of the world, being a follower of Christ means that they will spend

many years in prison, will be tortured, experience suffering and various limitations, and could even die.

While having the freedom to express our faith, let us not forget our brothers and sisters who are experiencing intense persecution in various countries, especially in Muslim countries. On March 8, three Christians, including a pregnant woman in Iran, received a 40-year prison sentence. In Congo, 70 Christians were beheaded. Only God knows how many Christians are persecuted in North Korea, African countries, Afghanistan, Pakistan... This list can go on and on. If you are a member of the body of Christ – His Church, please pray about these martyrs. "And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it" (1 Cor. 12:26), and, "The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much" (James 5:16). More details...
